HOW IT WORKS

Step 1: Register at kidswalkmsk.org Become a team captain and start a team, join an existing team, or take part as an individual.

Step 2: Raise Money You'll receive an online fundraising page, where you can share why you're walking. We also have tons of fundraising tips and are happy to help!

Step 3: Walk! Gather in Central Park on May 5 to walk and celebrate the difference you're making. There will also be music, activities, a speaking program, and much more!

Step 4: Research 100% of every dollar raised goes directly to pediatric cancer research at MSK.
